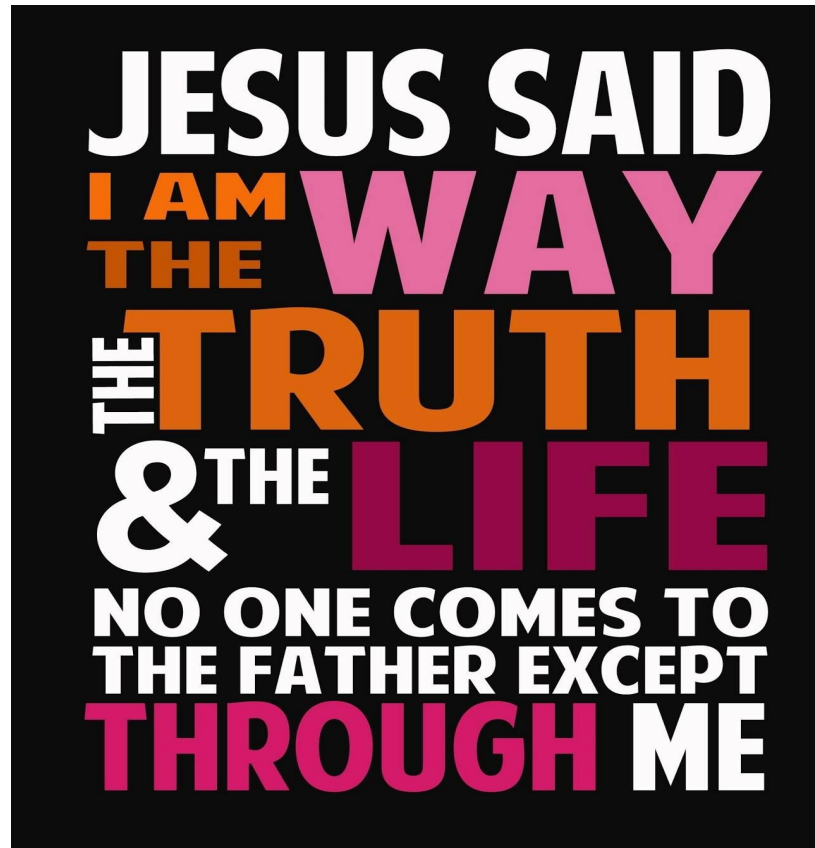

The bible study in West Sedona resumes on June 6th at The Gathering Place at 1:30 p.m.

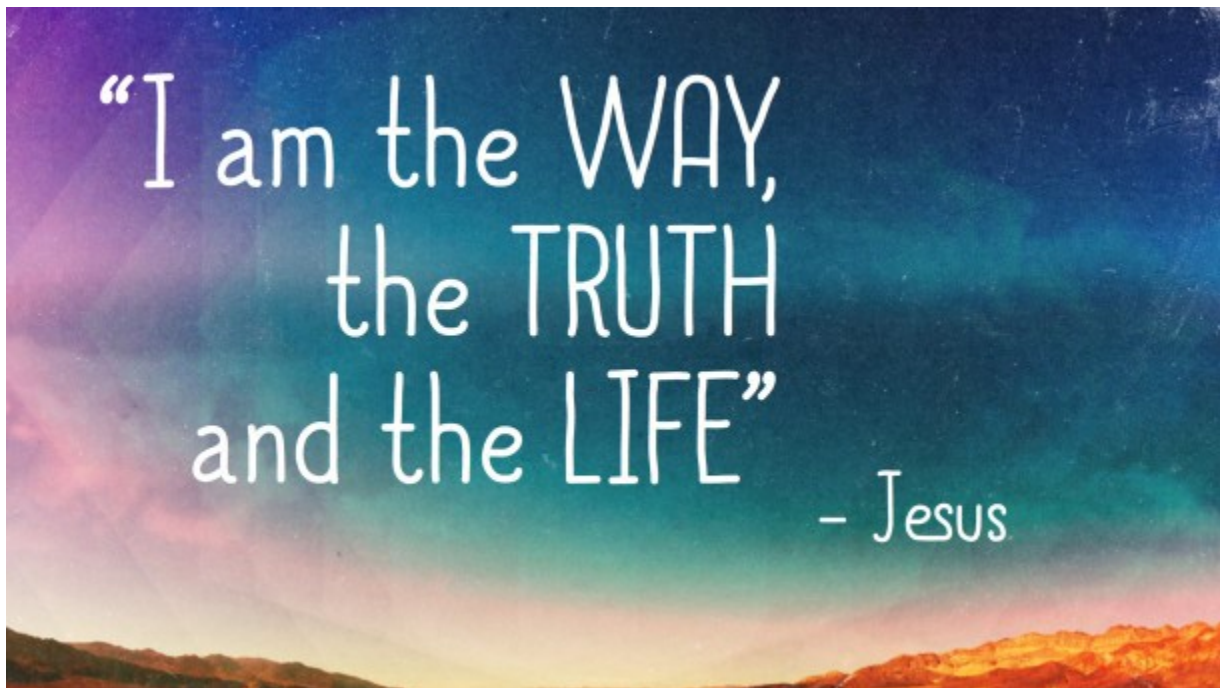
The Women's Bible Study Group will take a break in June and resume on July 13th.
